Elections for officers are next month. Anyone wishing to be considered for an officer's position should contact Tex Harrison.


Show and Tell

Training Column- SPAM Email

I know this is a little off topic, but several of you have reported that you are getting fictitious email from me with bogus links in the body of the email. DO NOT CLICK THOSE LINKS! I want to reassure the club that I do use anti-virus software and anti-malware software. Further, I use a robust firewall. I also did an extra scan on my computer just to be sure. It found nothing.

If I had to guess, the culprit is probably the email I send out to the club monthly informing club members that the latest newsletter has been posted. It is highly possible that a club member has an infected computer, and the malware on the infected computer is harvesting names from the monthly email. If so, and to help mitigate any additional shenanigans, I will use the blind carbon copy feature available in Outlook to hide the names and email addresses of the club members in the monthly email.

I encourage you to use anti-virus and anti-malware software. There are several FREE programs available to use that are very good and highly rated. If I can be of assistance, please contact me.
