

I would like to share with you one of my favorite websites/ YouTube channels. It is called Just Planes. Their website boasts the following:

"With an average of more than 60 million views a month (85 million in March 2022) Just Planes continues to be the most watched Aviation Channel on the net by far! This explains why so many airlines have already joined our Cockpit Series (300 as of May 2022) including leaders such as Emirates, Etihad, Qatar Airways, Turkish Airlines, Air France, Air Canada, United Airlines just to name a few..."

Their YouTube channel has more than 2000 videos. The videos that I have seen show GoPro cameras mounted throughout the cockpit of commercial airlines. Depending on the

specific video that you are watching, you will be able to see and learn about:

- All of the controls in the cockpit and their layout.
- Differences in design between different airplane manufacturers.
- Views out the window from around the world.
- Watch the pilots during takeoff and landing of the airplane.
- The contrast of older 747s with primitive analog gauges and archaic clipboards, paper and pencil vs newer jets with color digital displays and the use of iPads.
- The pilot's walk around preflight check of the aircraft.
- Much, much more....
